Applications are invited from the eligible Indian citizens for preparation of separate panels for filling up 4 (four) posts of Driver of the High Court at Calcutta, in the scale of Pay of Rs. 5,400/- 25,200/- (Entry point minimum pay of Rs. 6570/-) with Grade Pay of Rs. 2600/- [PB-2] (pending revision) along with other allowances as admissible under the Rules of this High Court. The appointment will initially be made on purely temporary basis but is likely to be made permanent.

Essential Qualifications :-

- 1) A pass in Class VIII,
- 2) Must have up-to-date professional India Driving License (West Bengal),
- 3) Efficiency in driving cars/light motor vehicles of different categories,
- 4) A sound knowledge in Automobile mechanism.

<u>Age :-</u> Not less than 18 years and not more than 40 years on the date of application (upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years in case of S.C. and S.T. candidates only). Candidates belonging to Ex-Serviceman will get upper age relaxation as per existing Government Rules.

The names of the eligible candidates belonging to Exempted category and Ex-Serviceman category will be called for from the respective authority/authorities.

Candidates of *Exempted Category* and *Ex-serviceman Category* may apply directly also. No exemption of examination-fees will be available for these candidates.

NB: The SC/ST/OBC candidates of other States shall be treated as General Candidates.

- a) The candidates belonging to SC and OBC-B categories must possess the up to date certificates in the form as prescribed by the Government of West Bengal and issued by the competent Authority.
- b) The candidates who are in service of Union of India/State Governments and their undertakings shall possess the "No Objection Certificate" (including date of joining of such service) issued by the authority and produce the same at the time of verification of documents/further tests.
- c) The claim of a candidate for being considered as an Exserviceman should be supported by a certificate from the Army/Air Force/Naval head Quarters indicating therein the date of his joining the Army/Air Force/Naval, the period of his/her service and the date of his/her release from the Army/Air Force/Naval or the date of the completion of the period of his/her service requisite for being entitled to be released or transferred to the Reserve.

Eligible candidates may submit neatly hand-written or typed applications on plain paper of A-4 size (210 x 297 mm) with self-attested copies of certificate and testimonials etc. addressed to the **Registrar General**, **High Court**, **3**, **Esplanade Row (West)**, **Calcutta-700 001**, giving particulars as under :-

(1) Full name of the candidate (in capital letters), (2) Father's/Husband's Name, (3) Name of the post applied for, (4) Date of Birth, (5) Actual age on the date of application, (6) Address (Present and Permanent, along with Pin Code No.) with Telephone No. if any, (7) Educational Qualifications, (8) Other Qualifications, if any (9) Experience, if any (10) Up-to-date **professional** Driving License No. with the date of issue, (11) Whether belonging to UR (Exempted Category)/ S.C./O.B.C.-B (Exempted Category)/S.C. (Ex-Serviceman), (12) Nationality and (13) Details of depositing applications fees by giving Indian Postal Order No., Date and Amount.

Full Signature of the candidate with date must be given at the bottom of the application.

N.B. : Statements made under Item No. 4, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 must be supported by the self attested copies of the proper documents/certificates. The candidates belonging to Ex-Serviceman and Exempted Categorties, who will apply directly, shall have to submit the self-attested copy of the Registration Certificate issued by the respective authorities.

Fees:

Each application must be accompanied by application fees of Rs. 300/-(Rs. 100/- for S.C./S.T. of West Bengal candidates only) by Indian Postal Order, which must be purchased on a date after publication of this Employment Notification, and drawn in favour of the **Registrar General**, **High Court**, **Calcutta**, and payable at G.P.O. at Kolkata.

No fees need be given by the candidates belonging to Exempted and Ex-Serviceman categories whose names will be sponsored by the appropriate authorities.

Essential Supporting documents required :-

- 1. Two recent and identical passport size photographs duly signed by the candidate on the front portion of both (one to be pasted on the top right corner of the application and the other to be stitched/stapled with the application);
- 2. One self-addressed envelope of the size of 25 cm x 11 cm with sufficient postal stamp of **Rs. 42/-** for further communication through registered/speed post.
- 3. Photocopy of self-attested documents in support of date of birth (School leaving certificate/Madhyamik or equivalent certificate/admit card).
- 4. Photocopy (self-attested) of Caste Certificate, in case of candidates claiming 'caste-reservation'.
- Photocopy (self-attested) of identity Card issued from the Labour Deptt. Govt. of West Bengal (Employment Exchange Card) [Card No. X-10] in case of candidates belong to *Exempted Category*.
- 6. "No objection certificate" from concerned Employer in case of service-holders, and
- 7. Indian Postal Order to be enclosed with the application.

Incomplete applications/unsigned applications/applications submitted without requisite fees and documents, will be **summarily rejected** without any prior intimation to the candidates. No claim for refund of application-fee will be entertained nor will it be held in reserve for any other examination.

Mode of Selection :-

- 1) Candidates, whose applications will be found in proper order, shall be required to undergo a Practical Test in Driving (Full marks 80).
- 2) Qualified Candidates, who will secure minimum **50 marks** (out of 80 marks) in Practical Test, would be called upon for Interview (Full marks 20, Cutoff marks 05) from each category in 1:3 ratio (subject to availability) as per the number of vacancies available in that category.
- 3) Final merit list will be prepared taking together the marks obtained by the candidates in Practical Test as well as in the Interview and panel will be recommended consisting of two (2) candidates per vacancy, subject to availability.

Admit cards containing Venue, Date and Time of the Test will be sent to the candidates whose applications will be considered to be in order in all respect, by post. No TA/DA will be provided to the candidates called upon to appear in any stage of this selection process.

Admission to the test/examination will be deemed provisional, subject to verification and determination of the Candidate's eligibility and suitability in all respect. If at any stage of the process, a candidate is found to be ineligible for admission to the test/s in terms of the Notice, his/her candidature shall be cancelled without making any reference to him/her and without assigning any reason.

If a candidate remains absent at any stage of the process of selection/examination, including verification of their documents, his/her candidature will be cancelled.

In case of any dispute, the decision of The Hon'ble The Chief Justice, High Court, Calcutta, shall be final.

The Court reserves the right to offer appointment to an empanelled candidate, to the posts of Driver on the Appellate Side. Once appointed, the matters regarding service, seniority, promotion etc. in respect of an appointee will be regulated by the Rules of the particular Side or the Circuit Bench where he/she will be appointed.

The application must be submitted in closed envelope, superscribing thereon the post applied for along with the category, to the undersigned before **4:45 P.M.** on <u>18.03.2020</u>. Applications reaching the office after the last date shall not be considered, even though the same are posted well in advance.
