The candidates have to attach the self-attested copies of all the relevant certificates/testimonials for support of date of birth, category, sub-category i.e. educational qualification teaching experience, paper publications, Pension Payment Order(PPO), etc. with the application form and have to produce originals thereof at the time of interview.
- **D. TERMS OF CONTRACT:-**The tenure of contractual faculty would be for period of 03 years or attaining 70 years of age, whichever is earlier from the date of appointment. The initial period of contract would be for one year extendable up to maximum three years subject to satisfactory performance reviewed annually.
