The candidate should possess qualifications as per University rules mentioned below:

"Good academic record with at least 55% marks (50% for candidates belonging to SC/ST and those who passed their Master's degree (M.A. in Social Work) prior to 19.09.91 and hold Ph.D. degree or and equivalent grade) at Master's degree level or an equivalent qualification from an Indian or foreign University. Candidates, besides fulfilling the above qualifications, should have cleared the eligibility test for lecturers. (NET) conducted by UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC. However, the candidates having Ph.D. degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET for PG level and UG level teaching. The candidates having M.Phil. degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET for UG level teaching only."
