# Recruitment to the 62(sixty two) vacant posts of Assistant Professors in the cadre of West Bengal Medical Education Service

Online Applications are invited from Indian Citizens and such other nationals as declared eligible by the Government of India for recruitment to the posts of Assistant Professors in *West Bengal Medical Education Service* under the Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal.

## Online Registration will be allowed on the website between 12.10.2020 to 16.10.2020 (before 8 PM).

Posts are temporary but likely to be permanent.

## The relevant rules and necessary particulars are stated in the following paragraphs:

A candidate should verify from the notified rules that he/she is eligible for selection. The condition prescribed cannot be relaxed in any manner. The recruitment shall be made by selection, but where a large number of applications are received as a result of Advertisement, the Board may, for the purpose of short-listing, hold a preliminary examination.

## **Qualification:**

#### **Essential:**

- i. MBBS Degree included in the First Schedule or Second Schedule or Part-II of the Third Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (Act 102 of 1956) and requisite Postgraduate Degree for the Specialties Group and requisite Post Doctoral Degrees for the Super Specialties Group, <u>as prescribed by the Medical Council of India and specified in the 'Minimum Qualifications for Teachers in Medical Institutions Regulations</u>, 1998" as amended from time to time;
- **ii.** A minimum of three years' teaching experience, in the subject concerned in a recognized Medical College as Demonstrator or Resident Medical Officer-cum-Clinical Tutor or Lecturer.

Provided that the teaching experience rendered as Demonstrator or Resident Medical Officer-cum-Clinical Tutor or Lecturer during the course of Post Graduate training in that particular discipline in a Recognized Medical Teaching Institution shall also be reckoned as qualifying service for Departmental promotion/recruitment in such discipline.

In case of DNB candidates equated to MD/MS in terms of clause 4A of schedule I, in addition to 3 years' experience in the subject as Resident/Registrar/Demonstrator/Tutor/ or work experience gained during DNB training in a recognized permitted medical college in the concerned subject, 1(one) year as Senior Resident in the subject concerned in a recognized permitted Medical College.

## **Desirable**:

Publications in peer reviewed journals Indexed with Index Medicus or Journals at the National Level of the National Academic Organizations will be accepted only.  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  author in the publication will be considered.

<u>Age</u>: Not more than 50 years on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2020. Age relaxation may be given to such doctors who have served under this State Government to an extent equivalent to the period of such service, subject to a maximum of five years.

Provided that age may also be relaxable for the candidates belong to the categories of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes as per Government Rules or Orders for the time being in force.

## N.B

- i) Candidates should be registered as Medical Practitioner with the West Bengal Medical Council/ Medical Council of India/ Any Recognized State Medical Council;
- ii) Age as recorded in Madhyamaik or Equivalent certificate will only be acceptable;
- iii) The claim of candidates for relaxation of age as a Govt. employee should be supported by a certificate from the appropriate authority showing the period of his/her continuous service under Government and the same should be furnished when called for;
- iv) Candidates must fulfill the essential qualifications by the closing date.

**Fee:** Candidates must submit online the application fee amounting to Rs. 210/- (Rupees two hundred ten only) through GRIPS (Govt. Receipt Information Portal System), Govt. of West Bengal under the Head of Account '0051-00-104-002-16'. *Money Order, Cheque, Bank Draft, Cash etc. shall not be acceptable.* No application shall be considered unless accompanied with the requisite application fee.

Candidates belonging to SC/ST of West Bengal and persons with disabilities specified under Disabilities Rule, 1999 (certificates obtained before the Advertisement date) are not required to pay any fee. Such exemption of fee is, however, not applicable to any OBC (Category A or B) candidate.

No claim for refund of the fee shall be entertained nor will it be held reserved for any other examination.

Application shall be made in the format, as available, in the West Bengal Health Recruitment Board Website (www.wbhrb.in). Application received after the closing date shall be rejected.

Candidates should take particular note that entries in their application submitted to the Board must be made correctly against all the items which shall be treated as final and no alteration and addition in this regard will be entertained after submission of the application. **Application not duly filled in or found incomplete or defective in any respect or without fee will be liable to rejection.** 

In case, any of the statements made in the application be subsequently found to be false within the knowledge of the candidates, his/her candidature shall be liable to cancellation, and even if appointed to a post on the basis of the results of this examination, his/her appointment shall be liable to be terminated. Willful suppression of any material fact will also be similarly dealt with.

## **Particulars and Certificates required:**

(a) A candidate claiming to be S.C./S.T./B.C. must have a certificate in support of his/her claim from a competent authority of West Bengal as specified below [vide the West Bengal SCs and STs (Identification) Act, 1994 and SCs /STs Welfare Department order No. 261-TW/EC/MR-103/94 dated 06.04.1995 read with B.C.W. Department Order No. 6320-BCH/MR-84/10 dated 24.09.2010]:

In the District, by the Sub-Divisional Officer of the Sub-Division concerned, and

In Kolkata, by the District Magistrate, South 24-Parganas, or any Additional District Magistrate, South 24-Parganas, as may be authorized by the District Magistrate, South 24-Parganas on his behalf.

No claim for being a Member of the SC, ST and OBC or a Person with Disability will be entertained after submission of the application.

Persons with Disabilities (PWD) [40% and above] must produce a certificate from an appropriate Medical Board [vide West Bengal Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Rules, 1999]

- (b) The West Bengal Health Recruitment Board (WBHRB) may require such further proof or particulars from the candidates as it may consider necessary and may make enquiries regarding eligibility.
- (c) Original Certificates relating to citizenship (by registration), age, qualifications, caste (SC/ST/BC), Physical disability (40% and above) etc. will have to be submitted when the WBHRB asks for them. If any candidate fails to furnish any certificate or any other relevant document or information relating to his/her candidature within the time specified by the Board, his/her claim for allotment may be passed over without further reference to him/her.
