ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

1. For the post of Director, College Development Council:

Essential Qualification:

i) A Master's Degree with at least 55% of the marks or its equivalent grade of B in the UGC seven point scale.

ii) At least 15 years of experience as Assistant Professor in the AGP of ₹7000/- (pre revised) and above or with 8 years of service as Associate Professor in the AGP of ₹9000/- (pre revised) along with experience in educational administration.

OR

Comparable experience in research establishment and / or other institutions of higher education.

OR

15 years of administrative experience of which 8 years as Deputy Registrar or an equivalent post.

Mode of Recruitment: Deputation or on Contract for a tenure of 3 years or till attaining the age of 62 years whichever is earlier.

2. For the post of Assistant Professor in the Centre for South East Asian Studies:

Minimum Qualification is M.A. with NET/Ph.D. in Political Science / International Studies and Research work / Publications in South East Asia.

3. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE, PUBLICATIONS ETC. FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF SPORTS AND OTHER TEACHING POSTS SHALL BE APPLICABLE AS PRESCRIBED BY THE UGC REGULATIONS 2018/NCTE REGULATIONS 2014/AICTE REGULATIONS/ICAR GUIDELINES (AS THE CASE MAY BE) AS AMMENDED FROM TIME TO TIME.




GENERAL INFORMATION/INSTRUCTION TO THE CANDIDATES

1.	Application fee (excluding bank charges) of ₹1000/-(one thousand) for General/OBC category and ₹500 (five hundred) for SC/ST/EWS category must be deposited to Nagaland University Account No.3379758 1389, State Bank of India, Lumami Branch (IFSC No. SBIN0013380) . Counterfoil issued by the Bank/University Challan shall be attached to the application as proof of payment of fees. Application fees once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances. However, the candidates from PWD category are exempted from payment of application fee. Applications not accompanied by the prescribed fee shall not be considered for recruitment and be summarily rejected. No representation there after against such rejection will be entertained. It must be noted that the fee sent through Money Order/ Indian Postal Orders/ Crossed Cheques/ Currency Notes/ Treasury Challans/Demand Draft etc. will not be accepted by the University. Such applications will be treated as without fee.
2.	Sending of loose applications may be strictly avoided. The University shall not be responsible for any loss of documents in transit.
3.	The period of time taken by candidates to acquire M. Phil and/or Ph .D Degree shall not be considered as teaching/ research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions.
4.	Candidates should send self-attested copies of their certificates and mark-sheets from matric onwards in support of their educational qualifications, experience etc. Original must be produced at the time of interview for verification.
5.	Qualifications/Experiences etc. as on last date of submission of applications will only be taken into consideration.
6.	Application received after the last date shall be rejected.
7.	The University will not be responsible for non-receipt of any application due to postal delay.
8.	No interim correspondence shall be entertained & canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
9.	Separate applications Form and Fee are required for each post in case candidates intending to apply for more than one post.
10.	Persons who are already working in the service under State/ Central Government or any other organization should send their applications through proper channel. However, advance copy may be submitted. In such cases “NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE” from the employer must be produced at the time of interview.
11.	The University shall have the right to restrict the number of candidates for interview on the basis of qualifications and experience who posses higher than the minimum prescribed or by any other conditions as per the rules. The decision of the Screening Committee in regard to short listing the candidates from amongst the total number of applications received, shall be binding for all.
12.	The University, after considering the applicants for the post applied for, if it is of the opinion that he/she will be suitable choice for the next lower post, may make such offer, on availability of vacancy.
13.	University shall verify the antecedents or documents submitted by candidates at any time during the process of recruitment/service. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted by the candidates are fake or the candidates has a clandestine antecedents/background for which he/she has been convicted by any court and has suppressed the said information, then his/her service shall be liable to be terminated.
14.	Submission of wrong/false information, if detected at any stage of the recruitment, the University reserves the right to withdraw/cancel any appointment made to the candidates.



15.	In case of any dispute/ambiguity that may occur in the process of Selection, the decision of the University shall be final and binding.
16.	A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and Masters level for the SC/ST/Differently-abled (physically and visually differently-abled)/Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
17.	Candidates claiming relaxation under reservation should submit a certificate of proof and clearly indicate in their application as "Reserved Category".
18.	Person suffering from not less than 40% of the relevant disability shall alone be eligible for the benefit of reservation for Person with Disabilities.
19.	Candidates applying against OBC Reserved post must submit Non-Creamy Layer Certificate
20.	The University reserves the right to increase / decrease the number of posts and accept or reject application(s) without assigning any reasons.
21.	The Selection Committee may decide its own method of evaluating the performance of the Candidates.
22.	The rules of UGC/Govt. of India in regard to Pay and Allowances, Leave, Pension & Provident Fund shall be followed subject to amendments if any, from time to time. New entrants shall be covered by the National Pension Scheme (NPS).
23.	Applications received late or without necessary supporting documents, Degree/ Certificate/ Mark sheets and experience certificate, not self attested or not accompanied by the prescribed counter foil of the prescribed fee shall be rejected summarily.
24.	The selected candidates for appointment shall have to enter an agreement with the University to serve at least for a minimum period of 5 (five) years from the date of joining.
25.	Wherever the grading system is followed, equivalent percentage must be indicated in the relevant column of the application.
26.	Any Corrigendum/change/update related to the recruitment process shall be placed only on the official website of Nagaland University. www.nagalanduniversity.ac.in .
