II. <u>Period of Contract and Place of Posting:</u>

- a) All posts above are temporary in nature and **for a maximum period of 3 years** subject to project requirements and individual performance.
- b) For all posts, the posting shall be at Hooghly Cochin Shipyard Limited (HCSL), Kolkata/ other project sites as desired by HCSL.

IV. <u>Age:</u>

(i) Project Officer:

- a) **Age shall not exceed 30 years as on 31 December 2020**. The upper age limit is relaxable by 3 years for OBC (Non Creamy Layer) candidates in posts reserved for them. The upper age is relaxable by 10 years for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD).
- b) Age relaxation for Ex-servicemen shall be as per Government of India guidelines. However, in no case, age limit after applying all age relaxations shall exceed 45 years.

(ii) Medical Officer:

Age shall not exceed 58 years as on **31 December 2020**.

V. <u>Method of Selection:</u>

- a) For the post of **Medical Officer**, the method of selection shall be through **Personal Interview** (Out of 100 Marks).
- b) For the posts of **Project Officer**, the method of selection shall be through **Personal Interview.** The weightages are assigned to the following parameters for the final selection:-

- c) For the posts of **Project Officer**, the marks for Work experience shall be awarded based on the relevance of experience to the notified post.
- d) The selection process shall be held at Cochin Shipyard Ltd, Kochi or interview through electronic media in view of Covid-19 pandemic issues.
- e) Candidates who are short-listed, based on the eligibility requirements, shall only be allowed to attend the Personal Interview.
- f) However, CSL on behalf of HCSL reserves the right to fix minimum marks for pass in the final selection at its sole discretion.

VI. <u>Conditions:</u>

a) <u>Reservation</u>

- i) Government of India Directives on reservation applicable for Scheduled caste (SC)/ Scheduled Tribe (ST)/ Other Backward Class (OBC)/ OBC (Minority)/ Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) /Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD)/ Ex-servicemen (ESM) candidates shall apply subject to meeting the eligibility requirements.
- ii) In the case of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD), the degree of disability should be a minimum of 40%. The applicant should submit a *valid Certificate of disability* to this effect in the prescribed format issued by Competent Authority as per the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017.

 iii) Applicants belonging to OBC (Non Creamy Layer), should produce a <u>valid recent community</u> <u>certificate</u> in the prescribed format issued by the Revenue Authority not below the rank of the Thahsildar, failing which their candidature shall not be considered against respective categories.

b) <u>Qualification</u>

- i) The minimum qualification stipulated for all the posts must be from a University/ Examination Board recognized by AICTE/ appropriate statutory authority in India/State/Central Government.
- ii) Those applicants having qualifications equivalent to any of the prescribed qualifications should submit Equivalency Certificate issued by the Competent Authority and without such Certificate, their candidature shall not be considered.
- iii) For the posts of Project Officer, the applicants are required to fill in the exact percentage of marks scored by them in the qualifying examination in the online application submitted for the posts. Some Universities/Institutes/ Examination Boards do not award Class or Percentage of marks and allot Aggregate Grade Points (e.g. CGPA/OGPA/CPI, etc.). In case University/Institute / Examination Board defines criteria for conversion of Aggregate Grade Point into Class and/or percentage of marks, the same shall be accepted. However, where the University/ Institute/ Examination does not define criteria for conversion of Aggregate Grade Point into Class and/or percentage of marks, the Aggregate Grade Points may be multiplied by 10 to get the required percentage of marks.

c) <u>Experience</u>

- i) Experience acquired after the date of passing of the qualification stipulated as per item I above shall only be considered. Period of post qualification experience shall be reckoned as on 31 December 2020.
- ii) For the posts of Project Officer, the period of Apprenticeship Training in the relevant discipline under the Apprentices Act 1961, shall be treated as experience. Any training with remuneration shall also be treated as experience.
- iii) For the posts of Project Officer, Experience Certificates obtained from Companies registered under the Companies Act 1956 or Foreign Companies shall only be considered for short listing to attend selection process.
- iv) Applicants who are presently working in any company (Private/Public Sector/Govt), in the absence of experience certificate, should submit copy of **Appointment/Offer letter issued by the company, latest Pay Slip/copy of last Pay drawn** as proof of experience. **For past employment, experience certificate indicating the date of joining as well as relieving should be submitted.** The candidates should submit all certificates to establish the experience claimed in their online application, failing which their candidature shall be cancelled and they shall not be considered for further selection.
- v) Applicants who are Ex-servicemen should submit Discharge Certificate/ Book/Pension Payment Order from the Armed Forces. For the post of Project Officer, those ex-servicemen having Degree endorsed in their Discharge Certificate/Book should have working experience in the relevant discipline in the Armed Forces. Ex-servicemen claiming equivalency of Degree should produce the certificate of equivalency or endorsement in the Discharge certificate of the same with authority (refer order issued by the Govt of India),

should produce certificates indicating qualification and work experience in the relevant discipline in the Armed Forces, as proof of experience. They should produce experience certificate from the authorities concerned, failing which their candidature shall not be considered.

vi) For the posts of Project Officer, Work experience obtained from contractors (Proprietary Firms and Partnership Firms) engaged by registered companies may be considered based on the endorsement of the Principal Employer on the certificates issued by the contractor. Such applicants are required to submit their experience certificates along with further proof such as ESI/EPF statements. Certificates of training issued by the contractors without the endorsement of the Principal Employer shall not be considered.

d) <u>Application fee</u>

- i) Application fee of ₹ 400/- (Non refundable, plus bank charges extra) should be remitted using the Online payment options (Debit card/Credit card/Internet Banking) which can be accessed through our Online application facility from 16 December 2020 to 31 December 2020. No other mode of payment shall be accepted.
- ii) Applicants belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC)/ Scheduled Tribe (ST)/ Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) need not pay application fee. They are exempted from payment of application fee.
- iii) All applicants for whom the fee is applicable, i.e. except those belonging to SC/ST/PwBD, should pay the application fee as stipulated in clause d(i) above. It is important to note that their candidature shall be considered only on receipt of application fee.

e) <u>How to apply</u>

- iii) Before filling up the online application, all certificates towards proof of age, educational qualification, experience, caste, disability etc and a recent passport size colour photograph shall be kept ready in the system for uploading to the SAP online application portal.
- iv) <u>Applicants should ensure that all certificates towards proof of age, educational</u> <u>qualification, experience, caste, disability etc and a recent passport size colour photograph</u> <u>are uploaded in the SAP online application portal, failing which their candidature shall not</u> <u>be considered and shall be rejected.</u>

- v) Applicants should ensure that all the entries have been correctly filled in and application submitted successfully. Filling of garbage/junk details in any of the fields can lead to rejection of your application.
- vi) Application must be complete in all respects as per this Advertisement Notification. **Please note that incomplete applications /withdrawn applications / applications in draft status shall not be considered. f) <u>General</u>

- i) Applicants are advised to make sure that they are meeting the eligibility requirements as per the vacancy notification for the posts before submitting the applications.
- ii) Definition of Ex-serviceman:- Ex-serviceman is a person
 - (a) Who has served in any rank whether as combatant or non-combatant in a Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union, and
 - (i) Who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service whether at his own request or being relieved by the employer after earning his or her pension; or

 - (iii) Who has been released from such service as a result of reduction in establishment;
 - (b) Who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request, or by way of dismissal, or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity; and includes personnel of the Territorial Army, namely, pension holders for continuous embodied service or broken spells of qualifying service; Or

- (c) Personnel of Army Postal Service who are part of Regular Army and retired from the Army Postal Service without reversion to their parent service with pension, or are released from the Army Postal service on medical grounds attributable to or aggravated by military service or circumstances beyond their control and awarded medical or other disability pension; Or
- (d) Personnel, who were on deputation in Army Postal Service for more than six months prior to 14th April, 1987; Or
- (e) Gallantry award winners of the Armed Forces including personnel of Territorial Army; Or
- (f) Ex-recruits boarded out or relieved on medical ground and granted medical disability pension.
- iii) Shipyard reserves the right to call for any additional documentary evidence from candidates in support of educational qualification/experience/other notified eligibility requirements as indicated in their online application, and information/replies to such queries should be only through the e-mail <u>career@cochinshipyard.com</u>. However, Cochin Shipyard shall not be responsible for any delay/non-receipt of such e-mails within the stipulated date and time. Replies to any such queries received after the stipulated date and time shall not be considered, and no further correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.
- iv) The candidature of the applicants short-listed for the Personal Interview shall be purely provisional, subject to verification of original certificates in proof of age, qualification, experience, caste, disability etc at the time of joining.
