- **Part-A:** General knowledge including current affairs, basic arithmetic abilities, and knowledge in house-keeping, hygiene, food and beverage service, food production, traffic signs, traffic rules, office maintenance, office well keeping, office articles/equipment maintenance, etc. (The question paper will be only in Tamil).
- **Part-B:** General Tamil

Madras High Court Practical Test

(a)	For the posts of Chobdar, Office Assistant, Waterman, Watchman, and Room Boy: The candidates shortlisted, as stated above, will be called for Practical Test, to test their skills in office maintenance; office well keeping, House-keeping, hygiene, house-hold articles maintenance, Office articles/equipment maintenance, other office duties, house-hold duties including food production, cooking, cleaning, food, and beverage service, etc.
(b)	For the post of Cook: The candidates shortlisted, as stated above, will be called for a Practical Test, to test their skills in cooking, housekeeping, hygiene, house-hold articles maintenance, cleaning, food and beverage service, etc.
(c)	For the posts of Library Attendant and Book Restorer: The candidates shortlisted, as per merit, will be called for Practical Test, to test their skills in book maintenance, library maintenance, bookbinding, office maintenance; office well keeping, Office articles/ equipment maintenance, other office duties, etc.
