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graphs mensuration, Time and Distance, Ratio and time, time and work etc.
(e) Selection will also be subject to following conditions :-
(i) Verification of medical fitness certificate issued by Govt Hospital only (Certificate must be issued after the date of publication of the advertisement).
(ii) Verification of Caste Certificate.
(iii) Verification of education qualification certificates.
(iv) Verification of driving licence by DTO/ RTO as applicable.
(v) Verification of Character Certificate.
(vi) Post selection medical in Govt Hospital/MH.

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4. Scheme of Examination : The selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit. The selection process will comprise of physical, skill and written test. The written test will form overall merit and minimum passing marks are 33%. The written test will comprise of four parts as per the details mentioned below :-

The question papers of Written Test will be bilingual i.e English & Hindi. However, the question on the portion of General English will be in English only.

5. Syllabus for Examination :

- (a) General Intelligence & Reasoning :** The questions will be of 10th standard and would include questions of non-verbal type. The test may include question on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, figure classification, arithmetical number series, non-verbal series. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship arithmetical computation and other analytical functions.
- (b) General Awareness :** The questions will be of 10th standard. The questions will be designed to test the ability of candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observations and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of 10th standard education person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic Science, General Polity including India Constitution and Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that, they do not require a special study of any discipline.
- (c) English Language :** The questions will be of 10th standard. Candidates understanding the basics of English Language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage etc. His writing ability would be tested.
- (d) Numerical Aptitude :** This paper will include questions on problems relating to Number Systems, Computation of whole numbers, Decimals and Fractions and relationship between numbers, Fundamental arithmetical operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Averages, Interest, Profit & Loss, Discount, use of table and
