Advertisement for the post of Adhoc/Guest Faculty

Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Center for Biomedical Research, University of Delhi, Delhi- 110 007 intends to appoint Adhoc/Guest Faculty in the following areas of theory and laboratory teaching and laboratory teaching for the academic year 2022-2023, if they are deemed qualified by the interview committee.

- 1. Theory Classes : Toxicology & Pharmacology, Bioethics & Biosafety, Application of Statistics for Biology, Human Genetics. Practicals based on above papers.
- 2. Position : Adhoc/Guest Faculty
- 3. Salary : As per UGC/University of Delhi rules

ELIGIBILITY

A. 1) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant /allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.

2) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR (exemption from NET shall be granted in accordance with clause (ii) & (iii) of General Note in the last section of this document). NET Exemption Certificate is must as a Proof in the case, wherever applicable.

Desirable: Candidates should have few years of teaching experience in the University /colleges/institute and must have taught them at the Post Graduate level.

GENERAL NOTE:

- Applications which do not meet the eligibility criteria given in this advertisement shall be summarily rejected.
- In case of any dispute/ambiguity that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the Center shall be final. Applicants are advised to satisfy themselves before applying that they possess the essential qualifications laid down in the advertisement.
- No TA/DA shall be paid to candidates for attending interview whenever the date is intimated.
- The National Eligibility Test (NET) shall be the minimum eligibility for appointment of Assistant Professor.

Provided that candidates who have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2009, or the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2016, and their subsequent amendments from time to time, as the case may be, <u>shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET</u> for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor in the University. Provided further that the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil/Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree.

An exemption certificate from the Registrar/Dean shall be submitted for the same. All such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professors in the University subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions: a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode only; b) The Ph.D. thesis has been awarded by at least two external examiners; c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted; d) The candidate has published two research papers from her/his Ph.D. work out of which at least one is in a refereed journal; e) The candidate has presented at least two papers, based on her/his Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/ funded/supported by the UGC/ ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency. The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

- The clearing of NET shall not be required for candidates in such disciplines for which NET has not been conducted. <u>NET clearance/NET exemption certificate is mandatory as a proof for the same, wherever applicable.</u>
- A relaxation of 5% may be provided (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university, at the master's level shall also be considered eligible.
- The number of candidates to be called for interview for the teaching posts in the University, shall be determined after screening of applications in accordance with the guidelines laid down in the Screening guidelines annexed with this advertisement. The interviews will be held in person at ACBR.
