ENGAGEMENT OF DOCTORS ON CONTRACT BASIS AT IPSHEM, Goa

Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC), a “Maharatna” Public Sector Enterprise, and India’s flagship energy major engaged in Exploration and Production of Oil and Gas in India and abroad, intends to engage Doctors on contract basis on the following posts at its location in **IPSHEM, Goa**:

- (i) Field Medical Officers (FDMO)
(Onshore posting (14 days on/off))

The details of posts, qualifications required and the honorarium to be paid are mentioned in **table A** below. The period of contract shall be from the date of engagement till **30/06/2024**. The job is purely on contract basis and does not carry any liability on the part of ONGC to grant regular appointment at any stage.

A) Details of the Posts, Essential qualifications and Honorarium:

Note:

- None of the posts are either reserved or identified for PWBD.
- The Candidate must possess the essential prescribed qualifications as well as a valid registration with the concerned statutory authority **on or before the last date of application**. Experience is desirable for all posts.
- Nomenclature of qualifications shall be as prescribed by UGC/ Medical Council of India.
- Qualifications equivalent to the one prescribed in this advertisement will not be accepted. This includes any equivalent qualification acquired from a foreign university.**
- Where the posts specified in this advertisement are not reserved for any category(ies), a reserved category candidate can also apply provided he fulfills the criteria specified for the post. However he/she shall be treated at par with Unreserved category candidates.
- Candidate’s seeking reservation as OBC, shall have to produce a certificate in the prescribed proforma **ONLY**, meant for appointment to posts under the Government of India, from the designated authority indicating clearly the candidate’s caste, the Act/Order under which the

caste is recognised as OBC and the Village/Town the candidate is ordinarily a resident of. They must also ensure that the name of their caste/community and its spelling in their caste/community certificate should be exactly as mentioned in the lists notified by the central government from time to time (for OBC category list of castes recognized by the Govt. of India as OBC castes in the central list is available on the site <http://www.ncbc.nic.in>). A certificate containing any variation in the caste name will not be accepted. Further the OBC certificate should also clearly indicate that the candidate does not belong to creamy layer as defined by the Government of India for applying to posts and services under the Central Government.

- vii. The OBC claim of a candidate will be determined in relation to the State (or part of the State) to which his/her father originally belongs. A candidate who has migrated from one State (or part of the State) to another should, therefore, produce an OBC certificate which should have been issued to him/her based on his/her father's OBC certificate from the State to which he (father) originally belongs.
- viii. Prescribed format of the certificate for OBC/PWBD for employment in government undertaking is down-loadable from ONGC's website www.ongcindia.com.

B. Age Limit

- a. There is no maximum age limit for applying.

C. How to Apply

- a) Candidates need to visit www.ongcindia.com to **register on our Registration weblink**. The registration site shall remain open from **31-05-2022 to 06-06-2022**.
- b) Candidates need to attach the following documents in pdf format in their online form on the weblink and submit the same:
 - i. Scanned copy of Aadhar card
 - ii. Class 10th Board Certificate containing Date of Birth (DOB). No other proof for determining Date of Birth shall be considered.
 - iii. All semester MBBS marksheets.
 - iv. M.B.B.S./ M.S./ M.D. Degree. In case degree has not been issued then Provisional degree certificate.
 - v. Valid Registration Certificate with the statutory registration Council like MCI/ NMC etc.
 - vi. OBC Caste Certificate / NCL certificate in central government format.
- c) In case of any difficulty in uploading their documents in the weblink, the candidates can mail the same on our e-mail id: rectongcmumbai@ongc.co.in before the last date of registration.
- d) In case of a face to face interview, candidates will be required to bring all testimonials **in original** along with a set of Self-Attested Photocopies of documents and report to DGM (HR)-I/C R&P as per date, time and venue intimated. Candidates will be intimated of the exact date and venue of the interview later.
- e) Shortlisted candidates shall be called for either a face to face interview or through video conferencing (to be decided later by ONGC) based on a preliminary verification of the documents submitted by the candidate. The candidates are therefore advised to submit complete documents and true and correct data in the weblink. In case of failure to submit complete information or complete set of documents, their candidature is liable to be rejected.

- f) In case of the interview being conducted through video conferencing, candidate will be advised the date and time of the interview through e-mail and through SMS. ONGC however does not take any responsibility of the mail being sent to a spam folder or the message not being delivered due to network failure.
- g) In case of video conferencing the following software shall be used for video communication:- MS Teams or Webex or Google Meet. For better user experience, candidates are advised to keep these apps downloaded. ONGC may add more apps for communication depending upon feasibility. Candidates will be informed of the detailed modalities for video conferencing subsequently.
- h) All communications with the candidate shall be through SMS / e-mail.
- i) Candidates may please ensure that they are fulfilling all the requisite criteria prior to appearing for personal interview, failing which, their candidature is liable to be rejected/cancelled.

D. Selection Criteria: Following weightages shall be assigned to different parameters in the selection process:-

Qualification	-	70 marks (60 marks for essential qualification & upto 10 marks for any relevant higher qualification)
Interview	-	30 marks

Total	-	100 marks

Note:

The breakup of 10 marks for such higher qualification shall be considered as follows:

- a) Where a Bachelor's degree in the relevant field (M.B.B.S.) is the minimum prescribed qualification, 5 marks shall be given to a Post-Graduation (PG) degree (e.g. MD/MS).
 - The PG qualification in Anesthesiology/Dermatology, Venereology and Leprosy/Family Medicine/General Medicine/Pediatrics/Palliative Medicine/Pathology/Psychiatry/Radio-Diagnosis / Radiology/Tuberculosis and Respiratory diseases/Emergency and Critical care/Ear, Nose and Throat/General Surgery/Ophthalmology/Orthopedics/Obstetrics and Gynecology/Pulmonary and Sleep disorders/Traumatology & Surgery/Otorhinolaryngology will be eligible for additional 5 marks for the post of Contract Medic - Field Duty. Other qualifications such as PG in Biochemistry/Forensic Medicine/Microbiology/ Pharmacology/ Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation/Physiology/Community Health or Medicine/Preventive and Social Medicine/Occupational Health or Medicine will not be eligible for additional 5 marks.
- a) Further additional 5 marks shall be given to a Post Master's qualification in the relevant field (e.g. M.Ch/ DM).

D. Qualifying marks in the interview shall be 18 marks for UR/OBC category.

E. Finalization of Merit List

- i. Candidates who qualify in the interview shall be empaneled in the Merit List.
- ii. Offer of appointment shall be issued to the candidates based on their relative rank in the Merit List prepared on the sum total of marks scored by the candidate in qualification and interview.
- iii. In case of a tie in the total marks scored between two candidates, then the candidate who scores more marks in interview shall be considered senior. In case there too the marks are equal then the candidate who is older in age shall be considered senior for issue of offer of appointment.

F. Appointment of selected candidates will be **subject to their passing the company's Medical Examination** as per standards laid down under ONGC Medical Examination of Employees Rules, 1996. Details of the rules are available on ONGC's Website at www.ongcindia.com.

I. General Instructions:

- i. In case of candidates submitting multiple applications, the last application shall be considered as final for consideration of candidature.
- ii. Engagement is purely temporary, on contract basis, and can be terminated at any time by giving one month notice, by either side.
- iii. Engagement on contract would be subject to medical fitness.
- iv. No claim for regular employment in ONGC, by virtue of this contractual engagement, shall be entertained at any stage.
- v. Selected candidates will be paid consolidated monthly remuneration as mentioned above.
- vi. On successful completion of one year period an annual increase for Rs.1,500/- may be considered for Field Medical Officers (FMO).
- vii. Field Medical Officers on contract are eligible for payment of two way air fare in economy/ premier- economy class in shortest route from family/ operating station to work centre.
- viii. Twelve days casual leave will be granted in a calendar year on a pro-rata basis. One casual leave will be allowed for a month. Maternity leave will be granted as per Maternity Benefit Amendment Act to the female doctors subject to fulfillment of eligibility conditions laid down in the act.
- ix. Selected candidates shall be required to sign a contract agreement as per the terms and conditions of ONGC.
- x. SC/ST/OBC/EWS reservation is provided as per government guidelines.
- xi. Contract tenure will commence from the date of joining.
- xii. The contract shall end on expiry of the prescribed period and no separate notice shall be required to be given.
- xiii. Candidature/contract of candidate(s) submitting false certificates or suppression/ submission of incorrect information shall be liable for termination / disqualification / rejection at any stage.
- xiv. Only Indian nationals need to apply.
- xv. No TA/DA shall be paid for attending the interview.
- xvi. Interested candidates fulfilling the above conditions will have to appear for an interview either face to face or through video conferencing (to be decided by ONGC). Candidates shall be intimated the date and time of interview through SMS/ E-mail.
- xvii. The selected candidates are to be posted in IPSHEM campus, Betul, Goa.

J. Medical Facilities:

Full time Doctors on contract shall be extended medical facility as mentioned here under:-

- In-house OPD facility where ONGC hospitals/dispensaries exist in respect of self, spouse & two immediate dependents i.e. children and/ or parents. However, outside reference for medicine/ consultation shall not be permissible.

- For Metros and location not having in-house pharmacy Rs.1,000/- per month to meet OPD expenses. This amount shall be paid on monthly basis along with consolidated remuneration.
- Family floater cover of Rs.7.5 lakhs for indoor treatment in respect of self, spouse and two immediate dependents i.e. children and/ or parents.
