JOB DESCRIPTION AND KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conduct daily environmental and safety audits.
- Inspect and examine health and safety related complaints, workplace accidents, outbreak of diseases, spill of hazardous toxins.
- Inspection of project sites, to ensure a hazard-free environment.
- Investigate the construction site to ascertain equipment, production, and material processes do not pose a safety or health hazard to employees, work guests, and the general public.
- Create, evaluate, and implement health and safety programs and strategies.
- Work closely with Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).
- Creating different frameworks that will reduce accidents and improve workplace safety.
- Verify the adequacy and safety of all work proposed tools and equipment.
- Train and conduct mock drills and exercise with workers on how to manage an emergency situation.
- Assessment and approval of subcontractor safety plans.
- Roll out Safety, Health & Environment plan, assist and guide site team to implement Safety, Health & Environment Management System across project.

- Advise and assist execution/service team to incorporate safety standards and procedures in all
 activities.
- Create Safety, Health & Environment awareness.
- Organize and conduct safety training for staff.
- Advise and work out on Hazard Identification and Risk assessment for new jobs and activities and guide site team for implementation.
- Review and update safety documentation.
- Carry out investigation of fatal/dangerous occurrences, review of all near miss, LTI and MTI & recommend appropriate corrective measures and follow up for action.
- Coordinate with Project directors/ heads to update on work status and level of safety standards at site.
- Coordinate for maintaining of PPEs specifications.
- Review and update contractor safety instructions.
- Coordinate and assist to organize safety events across site.
- Prepare and review safety training matrix for site.
- Submission of applicable statutory compliance report.
- Any other duties as assigned by the Management from time to time.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Nationality: Candidate from Indian nationality only.
- 2. Preferable Age: Candidate shall not be more than 35 years of age as on 31st August, 2022.
- **3. Academic Qualification:** Should be B.E./ B. Tech in any discipline and a Degree/ Diploma in Industrial Safety/ Construction Management
