# PHYSICAL MEASUREMENT ( AT RALLY SITE )

Physical measurements will be carried out as per the Physical standards listed as

## **MEDICAL TEST**

- 1. As per laid down medical standards at the Rally Site.
- 2. Unfit candidates will be referred to MH / CH / BH for specialist review Candidates referred for specialist review should present themselves to the nominated MH / CH / BH within 14 days of the referral and report back to ARO Sambalpur for issue of Admit Card for CEE, in case declared FIT.

#### WRITTEN TEST THROUGH COMMON ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (CEE)

- CEE Will be conducted for medically fit candidates at nominated venue. Location, Date and time of written test will be intimated at rally site and through Admit Cards.
- Admit card for the CEE for the Rally Fit candidates will be issued at
- Admit card for the CEE for the Review Fit cases will be issued after getting medically fit by concerned specialist / specialists at MH/ CH/ BH.

#### DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR RECRUITMENT

Candidates are required to bring following documents / certificates in original with two attested photocopies with them to the rally site :

- 1. Admit Card. Printed with Laser Printer on good quality paper (Do not
- 2. Photograph. Twenty copies of unattested Passport size colour photographs developed on good quality photographic paper in white background not more than three months old. Computer printouts / photo shopped photographs will NOT be accepted. Photographs must be with proper hair cut and clean shave (except Sikh Candidates).
- 3. Education Certificates.
  - (a) Education Certificates with marks sheet in original of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e. Matric Intermediate / Graduation etc from recognised School / College Board / University.
  - (b) Provisional / online education certificate should be certified ink signed by the head of the educational institution of concerned Board
  - (c) Candidates with matric certificate from Open School should bring School Leaving Certificate countersigned by BEO / DEO.
- <u>Domicile Certificate</u>. Domicile Certificate with photograph issued by Tehsildar / District Magistrate.
- 5. Caste Certificate. Caste Certificate affixed with photograph of the candidate issued by the Tehsildar / District Magistrate.
- 6. <u>Religion Certificate</u>. Religion Certificate issued by the Tehsildar / SDM. (if religion as "SIKH/HINDU/MUSLIM/CHRISTIAN" is not mentioned in caste certificate).
- <u>School Character Certificate</u>. School Character Certificate issued by the School/College Principal/Headmaster, where the candidate last studied.
- 8. <u>Character Certificate</u>. Character Certificate with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch / Municipal Corporation within last six months.
- Unmarried Certificate. Unmarried certificate for all candidates with photographs issued by Village Sarpanch / Municipal Corporation within last six months.
- 10. Relationship Certificate. SOS / SOEX / SOW / SOWW Candidates are required to produce the following documents:-
  - (a) Relationship certificate issued from respective Record Office only duly signed by Record Officer with Personal number. Rank Name and particular of the Record Officer issuing the Relationship Certificate with office seal / stamp is endorsed.
  - (b) A declaration to the affect as mentioned in the Affidavit on Ten Rupees Non-Judicial Stamp paper prepared by Ex-Servicemen (ESM) duly signed by 1st Class / Executive / Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site.
  - (c) Original Discharge Book of Ex-Serviceman also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in
- 11. NCC Certificate. NCC A/B/C Certificate and Republic Day Parade certificate should have photograph of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. Provisional NCC A / B / C pass certificates will only be accepted if authenticated by concerned NCC Group Commanders. No bonus marks are to be allotted unless the certificate (Relationship / Sports / NCC) have been verified. An undertaking to the effect will be obtain from the candidate Provisional certificates are accepted only during the notified rally duration neither earlier nor later. Bonus marks will be awarded only for the certificate /provisional certificate (subject to verification) produced during the rally. Candidates will not be permitted to claim higher bonus marks / exemption from CEE, for any such certificate obtained beyond the rally duration.

# 12. Sports Certificate.

- (a) Sportsmen who have represented India at International level and State at National level within the last two years. For list of sports under which, relaxation in physical standards is admissible attention is invited to www.joinindianarmy.nic.in website
- (b) Sportsmen who have represented District at State level and University team or regional team at District level with 1st / 2nd position within last two years. Sports certificates should be with registration number and from govt recognized sports institutes
- 13. Affidavit. Duly signed by candidate on Rs 10/- Non-Judicial Stamp candidate at the Rally Site without fail. Submission of Affidavit is Mandatory to gain entry into the Rally. Candidates WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to enter the rally without affidavit. Format of affidavit has already been given in rally notification issued on 05 Jul 22. - 14. Single Bank A/C, PAN Card & AADHAR Card. Single Bank A/C, PAN Card & Aadhar Card are mandatory documents for final enrolment for purpose of Pay & allowances and other social benefits scheme

# **SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Any candidate who had not received admit card 05 days prior to the Rally, may approach Army Recruiting Office, Sambalpur for further
- Candidate can apply in only one category. If anyone is found registered for multiple trade / category, he will be disqualified and will not be considered for any trade / category.
- **<u>01 October 2022</u>** will be taken as effective date of determining age eligible for candidate. Candidates to produce birth certificate at the time of preliminary document check.
- 4. Candidates are required to report at the Rally Site by 0100 Hours on their respective scheduled dates. Candidates reporting after 0600 Hours without appropriate justification will not be permitted to participate in the Rally, Candidate should be clean shaven (Except Sikh Candidate).
- 5. Personal e-mail ID and Mobile Number is MUST. All important messages will be sent to this e-mail ID/ Mobile Number like short listing / Call letter / joining instruction / result etc. Sharing of email ID and mobile Number is not permitted. Remember the User Name & Password for future use. ARO will not be responsible for not getting required information if e-mail / Mobile Number of candidates given is wrong /

- Candidates must carry their AADHAR Card which will be authenticated biometrically at the rally site. Ensure AADHAR details are matching with the details mentioned in the documents and the online application.
- Candidate must enter contact details and permanent home address exactly as per Domicile / Nativity / Permanent Residential Certificate issued by Sub Divisional Magistrate/District Magistrate.
- Candidate's Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name and DOB must be entered exactly as per Matriculation/10th Class Board Certificate.
- Candidate must enter contact details and permanent home address exactly as per Domicile / Nativity / Permanent Residential Certificate issued by Sub Divisional Magistrate / District Magistrate.
- 10. Those not in possession of required documents will not be permitted to participate in the Rally.
- For 8th Class Pass Candidates. 8th class pass mark sheet and transfer certificate issued by school (both certificate) should be countersigned by District Inspector of School / District Education Officer. In case the candidate fails to produce the document, he will not be allowed to participate in the rally on the ground of being in possession of Higher education certificate i.e Class  $10^{\text{th}}$  Mark sheet. Candidates who have applied for post of Agniveer Tradesmen (Class  $8^{\text{th}}$ ) will be allowed to take part in the rally, only for the category applied for, and will not be allowed to change their candidature to the Agniveer Tradesmen (Class 10th) category, under any circumstances.
- Tattoo. Candidates belonging to tribal communities / from tribal areas, are permitted to have permanent body tattoos on any part of the body, as per existing customs and traditions of the said tribe to which a candidate belongs. Such candidates will only be permitted on producing the following two
  - (a) Self certification certificate to be signed by the candidates.
  - (b) Certificate of belonging to a tribal community and permissibility of permanent Body Tattoo (s) to be signed by DC / DM or SDM of the District / Tehsil. (Name and designation of the concerned official must be clearly mentioned).
  - (c) Permanent body tattoos of religious sentiment are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm / back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection.
- Mobile phones are not permitted in the rally site.
- A Grievance Cell will be established at the Rally Site to redress any grievances. Candidates disqualified for not meeting the laid down criteria are advised to obtain rejection slip, before exiting the rally site. - 15. <u>Beware of Touts</u>. Recruitment into the army is a free service. Candidates are advised not to pay bribe to anyone for recruitment as it is based purely on merit. - 16. Modus Operandi of Touts. In the past, a number of candidates have been found victims of touts, fake documents / impersonation and in the bargain have lost their candidature. Modus operandi/means used by the touts
  - (a) Issue of fake PFT Slips/impersonation during various stages of rally. Conduct fake recruitment rallies
  - (b) Snatching / taking away original certificates from candidates who have been declared fit at initial stage and thereafter harassing them
- (c) Taking away "ADMIT CARD" from the candidates under plea that they will follow up their results.
- (d) Giving candidates false assurance of "RECRUITMENT" as they claim to have links at appropriate level, thereby winning confidence of
- (e) Once a candidate gets through on his own efforts touts demand money in return of the original certificates

# IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- Administration. Candidates are advised to bring sufficient eatables and drinking water with them since recruitment is a time consuming process.
- Candidates will be permitted entry into the rally site only on production of Admit Card in duplicate generated online through the official website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. Anyone found with fake admit card will be handed over to Civil Police.
- Recruitment into the army is a free service. Candidates are advised not to pay bribe to anyone for recruitment as it is based purely on merit. Selection process during recruitment at all stages is computerised and transparent. Therefore, candidates are advised to be beware of touts as they cannot help
- Candidates are advised to check their age & education criteria before participating in the rally. Candidates found under age / overage and not meeting education criteria will be disqualified.
- Giving / taking bribe, production of bogus / fake certificates and indulging in unfair means is a criminal offence and liable for punishment under law.
- Certificates with overwriting, tampering of seals or erasing/alteration of any type will not be accepted.
- All documents submitted by the candidates are verified by government agencies before enrolment into Army. Strong legal action will be taken against individuals submitting fake documents. Even after recruitment, the service will be terminated if candidates are found to have produced fake documents or gave wrong information at the time of recruitment, despite the number of years of service individual may have rendered.
- No compensation for Death / injury / loss etc during the rally and no travelling allowance / dearness allowance for journey is admissible. Candidates will participate in the rally at their own risk and the participation is totally and entirely voluntary. The signing of Indemnity Bond is a mandatory regmt.
- 9. <u>Use of Performance Enhancing Drugs.</u> Use of any kind of performance enhancing drugs is strictly banned. Candidates having been found to have used the same will be debarred from further screening
- 11. If 180 days or more lapse between screening medical at the rally and despatch, medical will be done again and unfit candidates in this review will not be recruited.
- 12. Candidates are advised in their own interest to undergo medical exam before coming for selection especially with respect to flat foot, poor vision, deformities and physical measurements. All are advised to ensure that their ears are free of wax by getting it cleaned by a doctor prior to the rally.
- 13. Candidates may have to present themselves at rally site for three to four days. Candidates should make arrangements for stay under their own
