- 3. Application forms needs to be typed according to the prescribed format and must be accompanied by self-attested: (a) Scanned copies of educational qualifications, and (b) Scanned copies of experience letter/certificates, etc., failing which applications will not be considered.
- 4. Candidates can apply for multiple positions if eligible. Please make separate applications for different posts.
- 5. Shortlisting of application for online interview of applications will be based on essential qualification, age limit, NET/ GATE qualification, percentage of marks in bachelor's and Master's, specialization relevance in Masters, research experience (Publications, Paper Presented in Workshops/ Seminars/ Symposiums/ Conferences), SOP and extracurricular activities (as per WII rules).
- 6. The applications received will be rejected by the Institute, if (i) receive after the deadline, (ii) not in prescribed application format or (iii) self-attested documents of qualification, date of birth & experience not attached or (iv) received without said subject line in e-mail/ post.
- 7. Mere fulfilment of the minimum advertised qualification and experience requirement DOES NOT automatically entitle an applicant to be called for online interview. The decision of the Institute in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of application, mode of selection will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry or correspondence will be entertained from any individual or his / her agency.
- 8. All the steps of the recruitment process will be conducted by a duly constituted Selection Committee. However, if the number of applications received for a particular post(s) is large, then Institute reserves the right to lay down any criteria for the purpose of short listing of the candidates for interview
- 9. All original documents/certificates must be produced at the time of joining for necessary verification.
- 10. At the time of the verification of original documents or even after selection, if it is found that an attempt has been made by the applicant to willfully conceal, misrepresent, or canvass the facts, such applicant will not be considered for selection and due action will be taken.
- 11.
