The selected candidate will be posted at IIMC's Regional Campus at Aizawl (Mizoram); however, he/she will be liable for posting in any Campus of the IIMC located anywhere in India. The vacancy is reserved for OBC category.
- 3. Qualification for the post of Professor:

Eligibility: (A or B)

A.

- i. An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2 of UGC Regulations 2018.
- ii. A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in University/College as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/ or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

- **B.** An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institution (not included in A above)/industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.
- 4. Scale of pay of Professor: Level 14 of the Pay Matrix Rs. 1,44,200-2,18,200.
- 5. Age of superannuation for faculty in IIMC is 65 years.

- 6. The Institute reserves the right not to fill-up the vacancy advertised, if the circumstances so warrant.
